

Resort Fact Sheet

The Reef Resort is the only all suites beachfront resort on Grand Cayman and the secluded East End location is highly desirable for travelers committed to a restful, relaxing, and rejuvenating vacations. The East End is one of the Island's best-kept secrets as it transports vacationers to the Grand Cayman of old, whilst offering some of the Island's finest diving and snorkeling sites. Regardless of how many suites are occupied, guests will always get the impression of spaciousness due to the large beachfront (1,600 ft) and the resort's low-rise building which hug the coastline.

Location

The resort's East End location is 25 miles, a scenic 45-minute drive, from the hustle and bustle of the Island's capital George Town, and the much-publicized 7-mile beach. Vacationers seeking solitude, uncrowded beaches, bright-white sand and an island-style retreat with boundless opportunities to enjoy nature will appreciate this resort's off-the-beaten path location.

All guests staying at The Reef Resort will relish all suite beachfront accommodations with private balconies and/or patio overlooks and the largest resort beachfront (1,600 feet) in the Cayman Islands. Guests can choose from 152, one or two bedroom beachfront suites/condos, with kitchens or kitchenettes:

- One-bedroom suites – offer 900 sq. ft. and are popular for families or vacationers seeking an extended stay
- Two-bedroom condominiums – offer 1,400 sq. ft. and a two-bedroom condo unit well-suited for small groups or families of up to six desiring a spacious getaway
- Deluxe studio suites – offer 500 sq. ft. featuring an oversized Jacuzzi Tub which are ideal for couples on a romantic retreat or just relax
- Studio suites – offer 450 sq. ft. and accommodate two guests. Ideal for adventurers on the go

- Please have your diving certification card or proof of training to dive
- Time zone – U.S. Eastern Standard Time
- Dress code – casual – shirt and shoes in all restaurants – no nude beaches
- Voltage – same as USA
- Currency for the Cayman Islands is the Cayman Island dollar but the U.S. dollar is widely accepted as is Visa/American Express/MasterCard and travelers checks
- Airport departure charge of \$12.50 per person (charge may be included in ticket – ask your travel agent)
- Legal drinking age – 18 years of age
- Internet Cafe –The Thirsty Surfer – The Reef Resort
- Most U.S. cell phones work in Grand Cayman; check with your provider for pricing
- Gratuities/Service charges – 15% is added to checks in many restaurants, but not at The Reef Resort, where this is left to the guest's discretion
- Room taxes and gratuities/service charges – 10% tourism accommodation tax is added to all room rates. Again, no room service charges are added at The Reef Resort, this is left to the discretion of
